

Noho's new loft conversion project revealed

Noho's latest loft conversion is christened the Schumacher, and will contain 20 apartments priced between \$3 million and \$25 million, Curbed reported.

Located at 36 Bleeker Street, the site of one of Noho's first commercial buildings that once housed the Schumacher & Ettlinger printing company, the Stillman Development International project that is being designed by Morris Adjmi Architects will hit the market later this spring. The building's apartments will have between two and four bedrooms and sport features such as barrel vaulted ceilings and arched windows.

The project is being marketed by Douglas Elliman Development Marketing's Fredrik Eklund and John Gomes. The building will also feature a central courtyard from MoMa roof garden designer Ken Smith, and an art program curated by Soho gallerist Cristina Grajales. [\[Curbed\]](#) – *Hiten Samtani*
